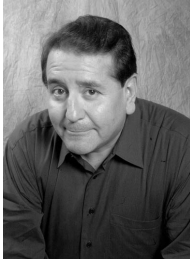


WE WELCOME "Wild Bill Garcia", our Master of Ceremonies

Happy Birthday, St. Jude – 40 years young!

St. Jude Children's Research Hospital is more than just a hospital...it is a symbol of hope worldwide.

In 1962, the late entertainer, Danny Thomas founded the research hospital in Memphis, Tennessee, as a fulfillment of his promise. A struggling young comedian, Danny prayed to St. Jude, the patron saint of lost causes, asking for guidance. "Show me my way in life," he said, "and I will build you a shrine." Not only did he find his way ... he founded what has become an internationally renowned research facility, based on a simple mission: "no child should die in the dawn of life."

As the hospital celebrates its 40th anniversary, physicians and researchers are coming closer to making Danny's dream a reality. Because of the work of St. Jude, survival rates for childhood cancers have increased from 20% to better than 70% overall. In addition, the staff is reaching new heights in medical advances, and scientists are expanding their focus on genetic disorders and international outreach programs. In 40 years, St. Jude has become the single largest center in the U.S. for the treatment and research of childhood catastrophic diseases, such as cancer and pediatric AIDS. Dr. Peter Doherty, one of its finest scientists, is a recipient of the Nobel Prize in Medicine.

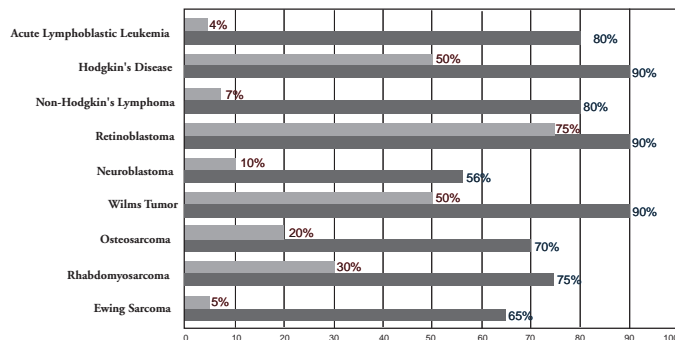
St. Jude has treated more than 19,000 children from across the United States and 60 foreign countries. The state of Illinois ranks fourth in the nation for children treated there. ALSAC, the fund-raising arm of St. Jude, was founded in Chicago, and eleven members of the National Board of Directors live in Illinois (nine from Chicago), including the Chairman of the ALSAC Board of Directors.

St. Jude patients are treated regardless of their ability to pay, with ALSAC covering costs beyond those reimbursed by third party insurers, and all costs when patients have no insurance. St. Jude accepts patients without regard to race, religion or national origin. Today, because of the continued support of generous donors such as yourselves, the researchers and scientists at St. Jude will continue their quest to eradicate diseases once believed to be incurable.

Just as Danny Thomas gave the gift of hope and of life to so many children, so do you in support of this Fashion Show. You keep his dream – and the dream of all good people – alive.
