

St. Jude Quick Facts

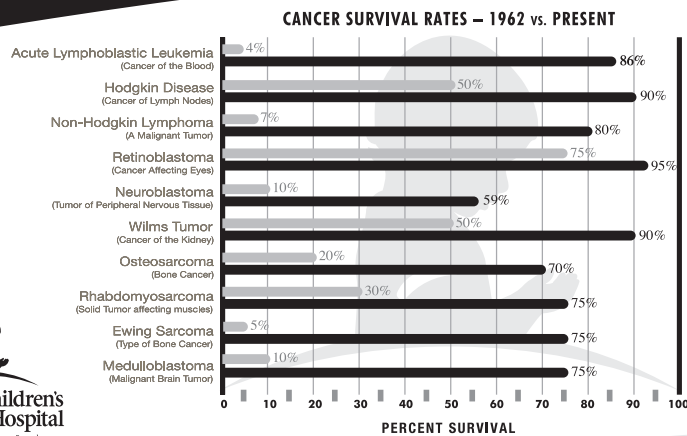
- St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, founded by the late entertainer Danny Thomas, treats about 160 patients every day on an outpatient basis and maintains 58 inpatient beds.
- St. Jude was the first institution established for the sole purpose of conducting basic and clinical research into catastrophic childhood diseases, mainly cancer. St. Jude is the largest childhood cancer research center in the world in terms of the number of patients enrolled on research protocols and successfully treated.
- Since St. Jude opened in 1962, it has treated more than 20,000 children from all 50 states and 60 foreign countries.
- Research findings at St. Jude are shared with doctors and scientists all over the world. St. Jude also enjoys a worldwide reputation as a teaching facility. The medical and scientific staff published about 402 articles in academic journals in 2003.
- St. Jude, which is non-sectarian, has approximately 4,300 patients in active status. It treats children without regard to race, religion, creed or ability to pay. ALSAC/St. Jude, the fund-raising arm, covers all costs not covered by insurance for medical treatment rendered at St. Jude. Families without insurance are never asked to pay.
- Each St. Jude patient must be referred by a physician, have a disease currently under study at the hospital, be eligible for a current research protocol and, generally, be 18 years old or younger.
- During the past five years, 84.9% of every dollar received by ALSAC/St. Jude has gone to the current or future needs of St. Jude.
- St. Jude pioneered a combination of chemotherapy, radiation and, when necessary, surgery to treat childhood cancers. The hospital continues to expand the use of bone marrow transplantation and gene therapy as treatments for pediatric cancers and genetic diseases.
- St. Jude researchers and doctors are treating children with genetic immune defects and pediatric AIDS, as well as using new drugs and therapies to fight infections.
- St. Jude was the first facility outside the National Institutes of Health to receive federal approval for research involving human gene therapy.

St. Jude Quick Facts

- Peter C. Doherty, Ph.D., of the St. Jude Immunology department, won the Nobel Prize for Physiology or Medicine in 1996. He shares the award with Rolf M. Zinkernagel, M.D., of the University of Zurich. Their findings have led to major breakthroughs in the understanding and treatment of virus infections and cancers, and in the development of organ transplant procedures and vaccines.
- The St. Jude faculty includes three National Academy of Sciences members: Peter Doherty, Ph.D., of Immunology; Charles Sherr, M.D., Ph.D., of Tumor Cell Biology; and Robert Webster, Ph.D., of Infectious Diseases. Sherr and James Ihle, Ph.D., hold the coveted title of Howard Hughes Medical Institute Investigators.
- St. Jude is in the midst of a five-year expansion that will bolster the hospital's research efforts and more than double the size of the St. Jude campus. The \$1 billion expansion includes establishment of the Children's Infection Defense Center and expansion of the hospital's International Outreach Program.
- Since opening, St. Jude has developed protocols that have brought survival rates for childhood cancers from less than 20% to better than 70% overall.
